ONE MORE GAME TO GO!



As Tropical Storm Isaac continues to head in the direction of the New Orleans area, the Saints decided Monday morning to call an audible on their planned course of action.

Already with a chartered plane at the ready to fly them to Nashville, Tenn., on Tuesday morning, team officials, wary that the impending storm could prevent their departure, changed their itinerary. Instead of flying to Nashville, where the Saints will play the Tennessee Titans on Thursday, the Saints decided to fly to Cincinnati on Monday evening.

The decision to move up the travels plans was made after careful consultation among Saints executives, team spokesman Greg Bensen said. Originally, the team was slated to depart for Nashville on Wednesday, but Isaac forced officials to push up plans and hastily call the players in for an emergency hurricane meeting Sunday, their scheduled day off.

Instead of being off Sunday, Saints interim coach Joe Vitt gave the players off for much of Monday, allowing the players time to prepare their families for the storm's arrival. During his press conference Sunday, Vitt acknowledged that Cincinnati was a possibility.

And after a night of following the developments of the storm, Saints director of operations James Nagaoka, who oversees all the logistics of the team's day-to-day needs, decided it was best to leave earlier. "He's been doing this

for us since Sean and Mickey have been together," Bensel said. "He's the best at doing this in the NFL. He has all these contingency plans done. With him, it's like bam, bam, bam."

The Saints considered flying directly to Nashville and practicing there. But the team's familiarity with Cincinnati and Paul Brown Stadium, along with the availability of hotels rooms and the proximity of Cincinnati to Nashville made the decision practical. Cincinnati, as well as Indianapolis, has long been on Nagaoka's list of evacuation stops.

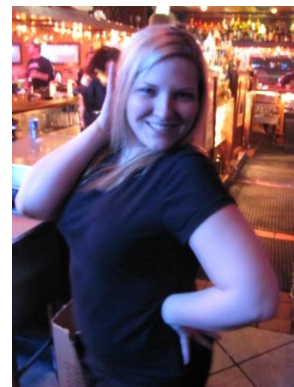

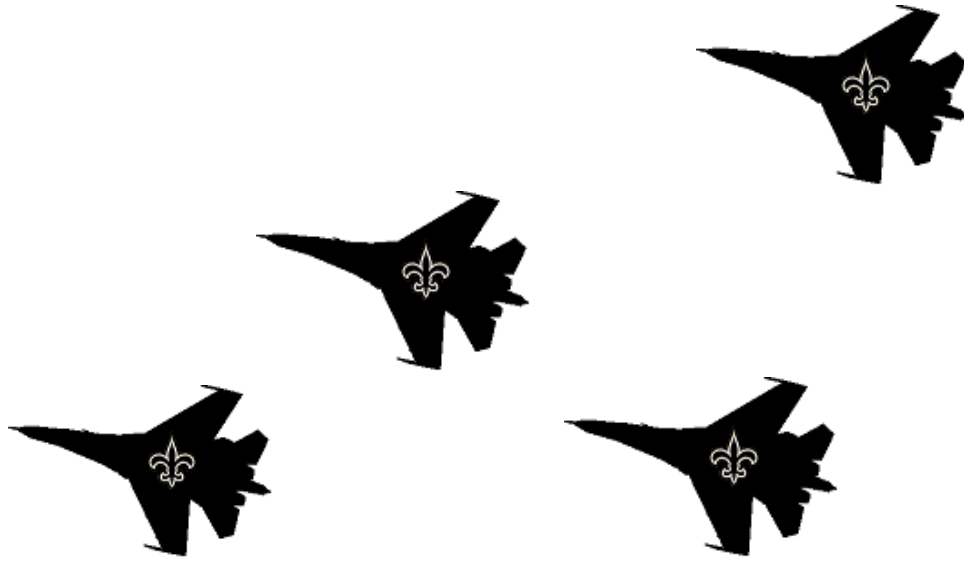
