A season-opening 40-32 loss to the Washington Redskins probably did nothing to change the minds of people who believed the Saints would be in disarray this season.

Despite the shocking loss, which was more surprising because it came at home and with the Redskins starting two rookies in their offensive backfield, the Saints have seen it at times -- even in their playoff seasons of the last two

years which is why the Saints are going into Sunday's game with the Carolina Panthers (0-1) in Charlotte with an understanding and belief that they'll be able to turn things around quickly.

In the previous issue; I mentioned that the Saints won 11 games after losing two games they were expected to easily win against Arizona and Cleveland in 2010 and while on their way to a 13-win season in 2011, they fell to a 0-6 St. Louis team and that that hadn't been the first time that a losing club had found "luck" for the first time during the season while playing against the Black & Gold.

"You're going to lose at some point in the season ... that's just the reality of it," said free safety Malcolm Jenkins, one of the defensive captains. "I'd rather lose early. You find out what your team is about. You find your identity, what your strengths and weaknesses are, and correct them."

After that bad loss to the Rams last season, a game in which Drew Brees threw 3 INT's and was sacked six times, the Saints, who also had a punt blocked, won their final eight regular-season games and playoff opener.

Well, if they're going to give up a fluke loss this season (which was inevitable) I'm glad that's out of the way now. Let's go play some championship caliber football, led by "The Aerial Assault".

Brees was 24 of 52 against the Redskins, which was only the second time in 96 regular-season games that he was under 50 percent. He's been under 50 percent just six times in his 155-game NFL career.

The only other time Brees failed to hit 50 percent of his passes with the Saints was on Dec. 24, 2006 against the Giants when he was 13-of-32 for 40.6 percent on a windy day in the Meadowlands....and they still won that game!

DID YOU KNOW THIS? Even though the Saints lost, Brees pushed his streak with at least one touchdown pass to 44 consecutive regular-season games. That leaves him three shy of matching Johnny Unitas' NFL record of 47 straight games.

WHAT ABOUT THIS? With playoff games, which aren't included for record-keeping purposes, Brees has a touchdown pass in 50 straight games.




