It's Do-or-Die for the Black N Gold here in Week 5! There's the rivalry match-up between Brees and Rivers, the breaking of Johnny Unitas' consecutive TD record, the aspect of getting our first win, the problem of getting our fifth loss, and of course, this is all happening at The Dome. Naturally, all of these things had to come to a head just before the bye-week and Joe Vitt's return. Hopefully, the Saints will be able to reverse the current-curse and go into the bye mentally strong and ready for a breakout second-half season.

While they're still down, the Saints are starting to feel a little better about themselves after Sunday's narrow 28-27 loss to 'The Pack' at Lambeau Field. Interim-Interim Head Coach, Kromer, who has only two games left before Joe Vitt returns (thank God) from a six-game suspension, believes the Saints are close to getting their act together after the near-miss last Sunday.

The reason for the optimism is because the "Aerial Assault" finally made an appearance after 3 previous games where the Offense just ran like an '81 Datsun and not at all like the Lamborghini that we've had the last 5 years.

Also, it’s good to point out that the Saints Defense actually should up for the game last Sunday and made some plays that helped give the Black N Gold at least an opportunity to hang on for a win, late in the game.

So, with that in mind, this Sunday Night at 7pm ‘The Quest to Win Again’ continues with a 0-4 Saints club (one of only two NFL teams without a win this season) that’ll try to finally break through against the Chargers who are 3-1.

Brees will try to break Unitas' 52-year-old NFL record for consecutive games with a touchdown pass Sunday night.

Brees, who equaled Unitas' record of 47 games with a touchdown pass in last Sunday's loss at Green Bay, will try to top it when he goes against the Chargers.

AN INTERESTING NOTE: Brees received a letter this week from Joe Unitas, who said he was a fan of the Saints' record-breaking quarterback and wished him well in his attempt to take the record that his Dad set with the Baltimore Colts from 1956-60.

In the letter that was posted on the team's website, Joe Unitas says he knows his famous father, who died in 2002, would want Brees to break the mark.

He also said that Brees is "a role model for today's youth, a family man, and a humanitarian who cares for his community," adding that Johnny Unitas held those ideals above records.

Brees will likely have to put the ball up a lot Sunday Night unless the Saints somehow find their running game in a hurry. With a solid game against the Packers to build on, Brees should be motivated to have another big game against his old team with a nationwide audience looking on.

The Saints have just six sacks this season and were shut out by the Packers last week after Green Bay gave up eight sacks in the first half alone of their previous game. Saints defensive coordinator Steve Spagnuolo has to come up with some creative ways to get pressure on Rivers to help the secondary out at least a little bit.

DID YOU KNOW THIS? The last Saints team to start a season 0-5 was in 1996. The same year that Jim Mora quit at mid-season.

WHAT ABOUT THIS? Since the 1990 season; after the new Playoff realignment, only 1 team with a 0-4 start has ever gone on to the Playoffs and that was the 1992 San Diego Chargers. It's time to pass-the-buton.

SERIES HISTORY: 11th regular-season meeting. Chargers lead series, 7-3. While the Chargers hold an edge in the all-time series, the Saints have won two of the last three meetings. Their last matchup was played in London's Wembley Stadium on Oct. 26, 2008 with the Saints winning 37-32. Since joining the Saints in 2006, Brees has passed for 29,744 yards....and the last time Brees did not throw TD pass was Oct. 4, 2009, 24-10 win over NY Jets....Brees already owns NFL records for single-season yards passing (5,476) and single-season completion percentage (71.2)....Brees has faced Chargers once since coming to New Orleans and that was the London matchup.
