*L*ooks like the Giants are gonna be un-defeated a little longer!!

According to an NFL.com readers poll the SAINTS are coming out with the highest percentage of the vote (35%) when asked which team is the best in the NFC....among the un-defeated. The Vikings coming in second with (28%), the Giants with just (23%) and “undecided” claiming the remaining (15%).

With the exception of this poll more and more analyst, broadcasters, commentators and other media folk are continuing to label the Giants as the “team to beat”....and the number #1 ranked team in the NFL?
