They've won four consecutive games by double-digit margins, stopping the Detroit Lions by 18 (45-27), Philadelphia Eagles by 26 (48-22), Buffalo Bills by 20 (27-7) and the New York Jets by 14 (24-10).

In beating the Lions, Eagles and Bills—all by at least 15 points—the 2009 Saints became only the third team in club history to win three straight by that margin or more. The SAINTS also did it in 1991 and 2006 en route to winning division titles both seasons!! Sound good so far? It gets better....

- RB Mike Bell said his sprained right knee would be 100 percent when the Saints returned to practice Monday following their bye week.
